Cable Installation Form

Owners are required to ensure that their cable installer observes **ALL** of the following requirements when mounting cable on the exterior of their residence:

1. Black cable - The cable color should blend in with the building (i.e., no white cable)
2. Securely attached to the building – The cable must be securely attached to the exterior of the building and not allowed to be slack or hang away from the siding
3. Routing – Cabling must be routed in the most efficient path that minimizes visibility (e.g., cabling to upper floors should be run along corners, when possible)
4. Roofs – Cabling cannot be run across roof tops

Note: If the cabling is not installed in accordance with these HOA requirements (or without HOA approval) the HOA may have the cabling corrected by its contractor and require the homeowner to pay for the costs of correcting the cable installation.
